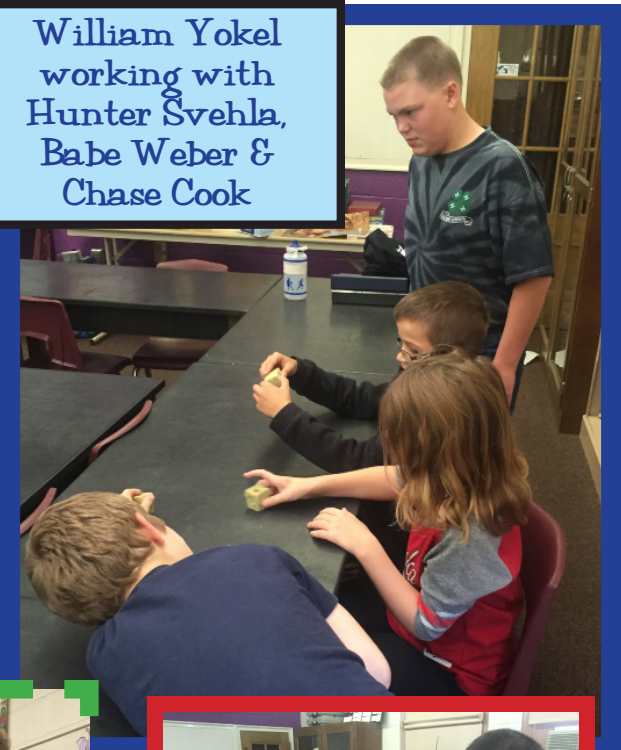


3rd grade & FFA students start a Tower Garden.....

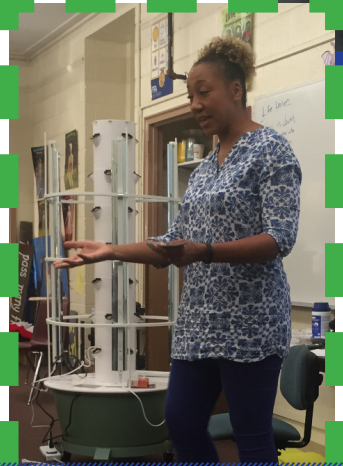

The 3rd grade class is partnering with the FFA Leadership this year to complete academic activities and share a mentoring experience. Their first activity- A Tower Garden! Both groups of students are learning the importance of nutrients in the process of plants. The Tower Garden is a vertical, growing system that allows you to grow up to 20 vegetables, herbs, fruits, and flowers in less than three square feet indoors or outdoors (we are completing this indoors!) The Tower Garden uses water and mixed nutrients to create a waterfall like sense to grow the plants (there is no soil used!) Students planted different vegetables and look forward to eating them and sharing them with the school once fully grown! The Tower Garden is a new invention that is coming into schools all across the United States!
