#### from Mrs. Dickinson Elementary Principal/Guidance Counselor

To The Parents of Friend Elementary Students,

Happy 2018!!!! I want to take a moment to welcome everyone back to second semester. I am always pleased to see the excitement on students' faces after they return from the holiday break. Everyone seemed glad to return to school and move forward in their learning journey. There is a lot to learn between January and May. As I visit individual classrooms and monitor academic progress, I am always encouraged to see growth occurring among all students since last August. As our school year continues, learning expectations increase. Making students accountable for their academics and behavior, gives them ownership and responsibility in the learning process. Let us all continue to work hard and excel. Our Friend Elementary students and staff always do their very best.

On Friday evening January 12th we will be having a Friend Family Game Night from 6-8 p.m. in the old gym. I have been planning this event for our Friend students and their families for the past year. Our school calendar is free of any sport/music activities, so this is a perfect opportunity to come out for a few hours to enjoy some wholesome fun. Families will have an opportunity to play some games together, converse and enjoy some concessions. Admission to the event is free. There will be a minimal charge for concessions. ### ACCREDITATION

Friend Public School is accredited by the State of Nebraska and the North Central Association. As part of the accreditation process, Friend Public School utilizes the Advanc-Ed process which is a rigorous, on-site external review to ensure all learners realize their full potential.

### **OUR DISTRICT**

Friend Public Schools is a state accredited Class 3 district located in the community of Friend on Highway 6 in the northwest corner of Saline County. The majority of the economic base for the 99 square mile school district is agricultural or ag - related. Adding to the \$460 million district valuation are locally owned industries and businesses.

The five year average (2012 - 2017) Prek - 12 enrollment is 271 students. There were twenty eight certificated teachers (26.93 FTE) on staff, and three administrators in 2016-17. Certificated staff to student ratio, based on the five-year average, is one certificated staff for every 10 students.

# **Achievement Test Results**

Friend Public School administers the NWEA MAPS Achievement Tests to grades 3-10 two times a year. The results of the 2016-17 spring testing for grades 3-10 are listed below.
